Insurance	It is responsibility of the students to insure themselves and their belongings while they are staying in Italy. Before their departure to Italy they are recommend to subscribe the following insurance policies: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- health insurance to cover any medical treatment that they might require during their stay abroad- civil liability insurance- accident insurance A copy of the insurance contract is necessary for completing the enrolment at the University of Milan. Insurance for civil liability and against accidents can be subscribed at the University of Milan upon arrival
Visa	The entry visa for study reasons must be obtained at the Italian Embassy or Consulates in the home country prior the beginning of the mobility: https://vistoperitalia.esteri.it/home/en
Estimated living costs per month	Euro 900-1.200
Credit grading system	Degree courses are structured in University Educational Credits (<i>crediti formativi universitari</i> or CFU). A university credit corresponds to 25 hours of work per student, time for personal study included. The average annual workload of a full-time student is conventionally fixed at 60 credits. To obtain the credits the student must pass the final exam Min. 18/30=sufficient grade Max 30/30= excellent grade.
Language Course	The University of Milan organizes Italian Language courses for exchange students (60 hours free of charge online course). Students are required to take a placement test . <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Fall semester: entry level test in September / lessons October-December- Spring semester: entry level test in January / lessons February-May
