The 4th International Conference on Non-Communicable Diseases HEALTH RISK FACTORS AND PREVENTION OF INJURIES AND DISEASES

This is an excellent opportunity to invite our international and national partners, to bring together well-known senior experts and talented junior researchers to discuss new research, ideas, and approaches. We expect a lively exchange of information in all subjects related to prevention and control of non-communicable diseases and injuries. The conference will be held on **June 03-05, 2026**, in Chisinau, Republic of Moldova. Additional information (program, time, and place, access, etc.) will be announced in advance before the conference.

Areas of interest for this Conference include the following topics:

- 1. Non-communicable diseases and injuries as a public health concern.
- 2. Health risk factors for non-communicable diseases.
- 3. Promote international collaboration on non-communicable diseases and injury research and practice.
- 4. Public health governance in the prevention of non-communicable diseases.
- 5. Role of health promotion and individual responsibilities.

Abstracts submission

To be considered, an abstract should respect the following guidelines:

- The abstract must be submitted only in English.
- Any abstract review will not be accepted.
- Abstract titles should be brief and should reflect the content of the abstract.
- Abstract should be 2700-2900 characters with spaces. The body of the text should be written single-spaced, 12 pt Times Roman font with 2,5 cm side margins.
- Abstract should be organized under the headings: Title of abstract (capital letters, central position), the surname and the name of the author (s), affiliation (institution, department, city, country) must be indicated for each author, corresponding author (surname, name, email address), ORCID ID for each author, Introduction, Aim of the study, Material and methods, Results, Conclusion, Keywords (5-7 words). Do not include references and figures, or tables in the abstract.
- The abstract must be submitted as a Microsoft Word document (doc or .docx format).

All submitted abstracts will be evaluated by the International Scientific Committee. Accepted abstracts will be published in the official Conference Abstract Book with an ISBN.
